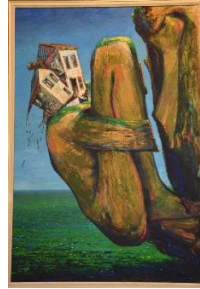

Norha Kam Holfod (1916-1990)

A Retrospective: Returning to Ripley Arts 50 years

15th to 24th October 2026 Open evening 15th October 7.30-9.30pm



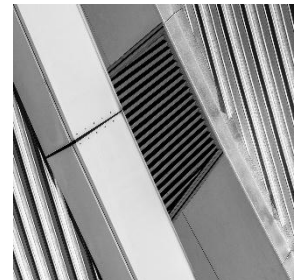
Norah Kam Holford (1916-1990) was an artist and educator of remarkable talent and insight. She studied at the Slade School of Fine Art in the 1930s, obtaining prizes for Life Drawing and Life Painting. She went on to train as an Art Teacher at the University of London Institute of Education, before teaching art at Bromley High School for Girls in the 1940s, and later, lecturing at Froebel Educational Institute before having children in the 1950s. Norah lived in Beckenham until the 1970s, and continued to paint and draw throughout her life, leaving a remarkable body of work: reviews from her previous exhibitions describe her as 'an artist of immense depth.'

This is a rare opportunity to see beautiful mid-century expressions of colours in nature, as well as some of Norah's more surrealist and thought-provoking work, created during periods of acute mental ill health and psychoanalytic treatment in the 1960s. She was a woman of unique artistic skill and vision.

Norah's art collection remains in the care of her surviving family. This exhibition has been curated by her granddaughter, Zillah.
